Other types of reading and writing, such as pictograms, are not based on speech-based writing systems. The common link is the interpretation of symbols to extract the meaning from the visual notations or tactile signals. Reading is typically an individual activity, done silently, although on occasion

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with that text. In this way, writing systems are distinguished from many other symbolic communication systems. Once established, writing systems on the whole change more slowly than their spoken counterparts, and often preserve features and expressions which are no longer current in the spoken language. The great benefit of writing systems is their ability to maintain a persistent record of information expressed in a language, which can be retrieved independently of the initial act of formulation. Reading for pleasure has been linked to increased cognitive progress in vocabulary and mathematics during adolescence. Sustained high volume

lifetime reading has been associated with high levels of academic attainment. Reading has also been shown to improve stress management, memory, focus, writing skills, and imagination. The cognitive benefits of reading continue into mid-life and the senior years. Reading books and writing are among brain-stimulating activities shown to slow down cognitive decline in seniors. Learning to read or reading skills acquisition is the acquisition and practice of the skills necessary to understand the meaning behind printed words.
